### Monday, July 8 Regular Day

- Camp shirts will be distributed.

### Tuesday, July 9 Regular Day

### Wednesday, July 10 Regular Day

- Parent Orientation for parents whose campers are going on overnight trips. We will meet in the POBMS auditorium right after the end of the day. Campers are welcome to attend.

### Thursday, July 11

- All non-trip campers will have a regular day.
- All regular camp trip campers ( grades 1-5 ) have an early in at 8:30 am for our trip to Splish Splash. All trip campers must wear their Camp Apollo "T" shirt.
- Campers can bring lunch and eat it before they enter the park ( no outside food is allowed in the park ). Campers may also purchase lunch in the park.
- If your camper has a specific dietary need and is unable to eat the food offered in the park, please notify the office as soon as possible. We will make special arrangements to have your child's non-perishable food be brought into the park.
- Souvenirs and snack foods are available for purchase.
- Campers can wear their bathing suit in the morning. If they do, please make sure that the camper has a change of clothing including underwear and socks.
- Campers should have a towel and sunscreen or sunblock. Water shoes are optional.
- We will be traveling on air – conditioned buses. You may wish to send a non-perishable snack and sweatshirt for the trip home.
- It is **STRONGLY ADVISED** that valuable jewelry, radios, electronic games, excessive amounts of money or other unnecessary possessions are not to be brought along on the trip ( including iTouch, iPhones, etc. ) . Camp Apollo, the bus company, and Splish Splash will not be held responsible.
- Campers will return to the main entrance of POBMS at the regular 5 pm dismissal.
