All campers are responsible for their **own personal property**. Camp Apollo and the bus company will not be held responsible for any belongings that are misplaced, stolen or left unattended. It is strongly **advised** that valuable jewelry, iPhones, AirPods, tablets, excessive amounts of money or other unnecessary possessions not be brought along on the trip.

Please keep in mind that we are traveling for short periods of time. One medium suitcase per camper is permitted. Please review the itinerary and the activity schedule and carefully decide what to bring. Please be reminded that you are responsible for your own personal property!

NO FOOD OR DRINKS ARE PERMITTED IN THE HOTEL ROOMS. Any food or beverage found in a room **WILL BE CONFISCATED AND DISPOSED OF.** Campers who ignore and violate this regulation will be reprimanded/disciplined.

There is a CURFEW each night. Campers **MUST** remain in their rooms at all times. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by Camp Apollo and its staff, the hotel and its staff or the Bus Company and its staff, i.e., smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, use of controlled substances (or possession of any of these), insubordination, or any other activity deemed inappropriate, will result in suspension, room confinement, and/or an early return home for the camper or campers involved at additional parental expense. Please note that anyone carrying or possessing anything that may be considered a dangerous instrument or weapon will receive an automatic suspension from camp. It is imperative that parents impress upon their children the need to behave appropriately and to follow ALL rules and regulations.
